- **Ownership:** By co-owning the planning and implementation of programmes, leaders of partner organisations signify the importance of the programmes and drive them to success.

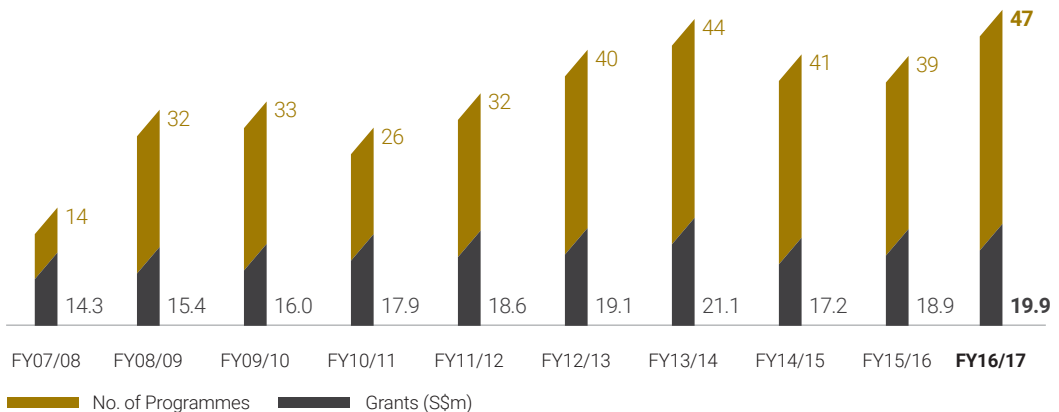

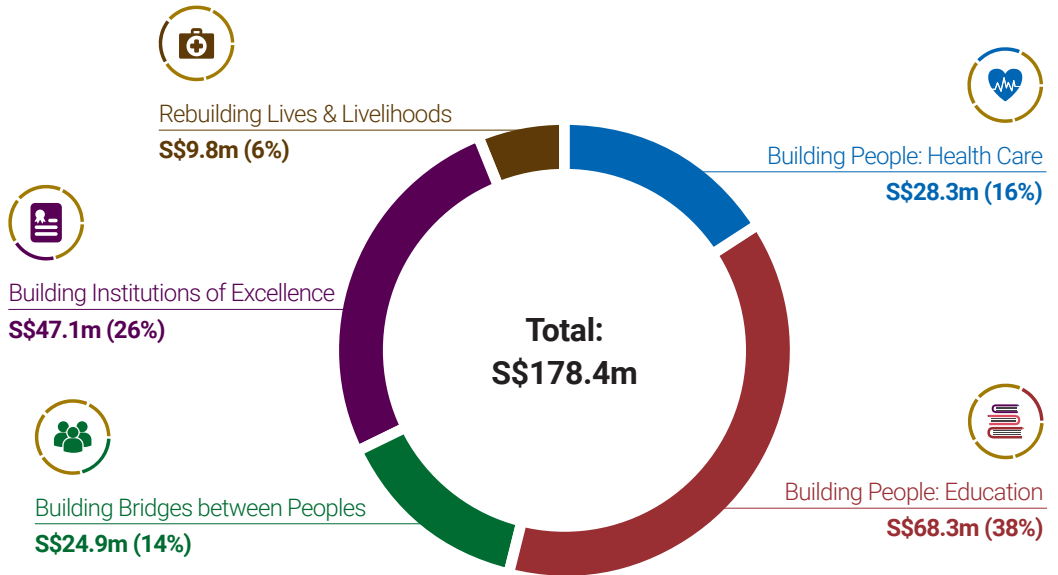

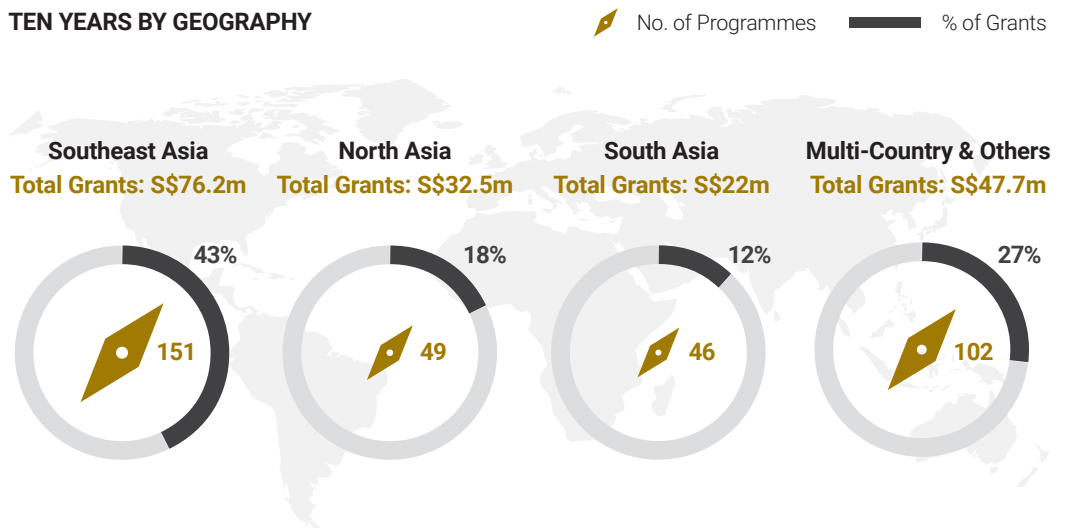

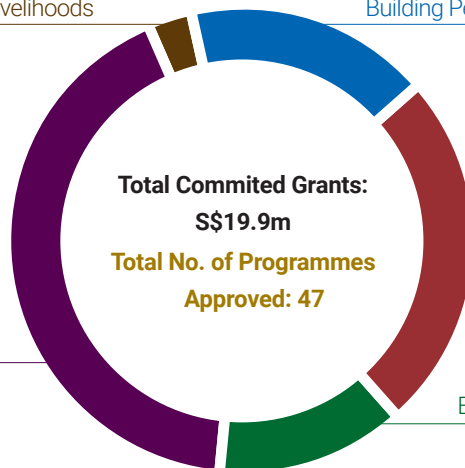
