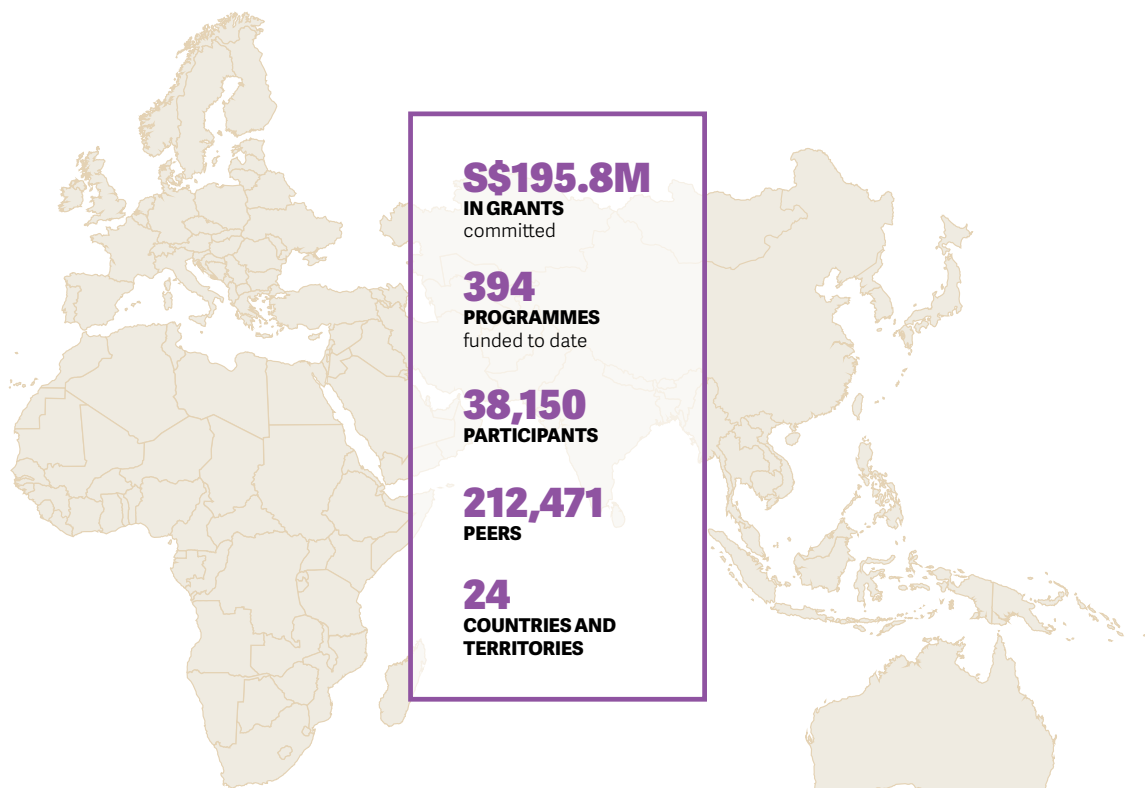

Our Grant-Making Approach

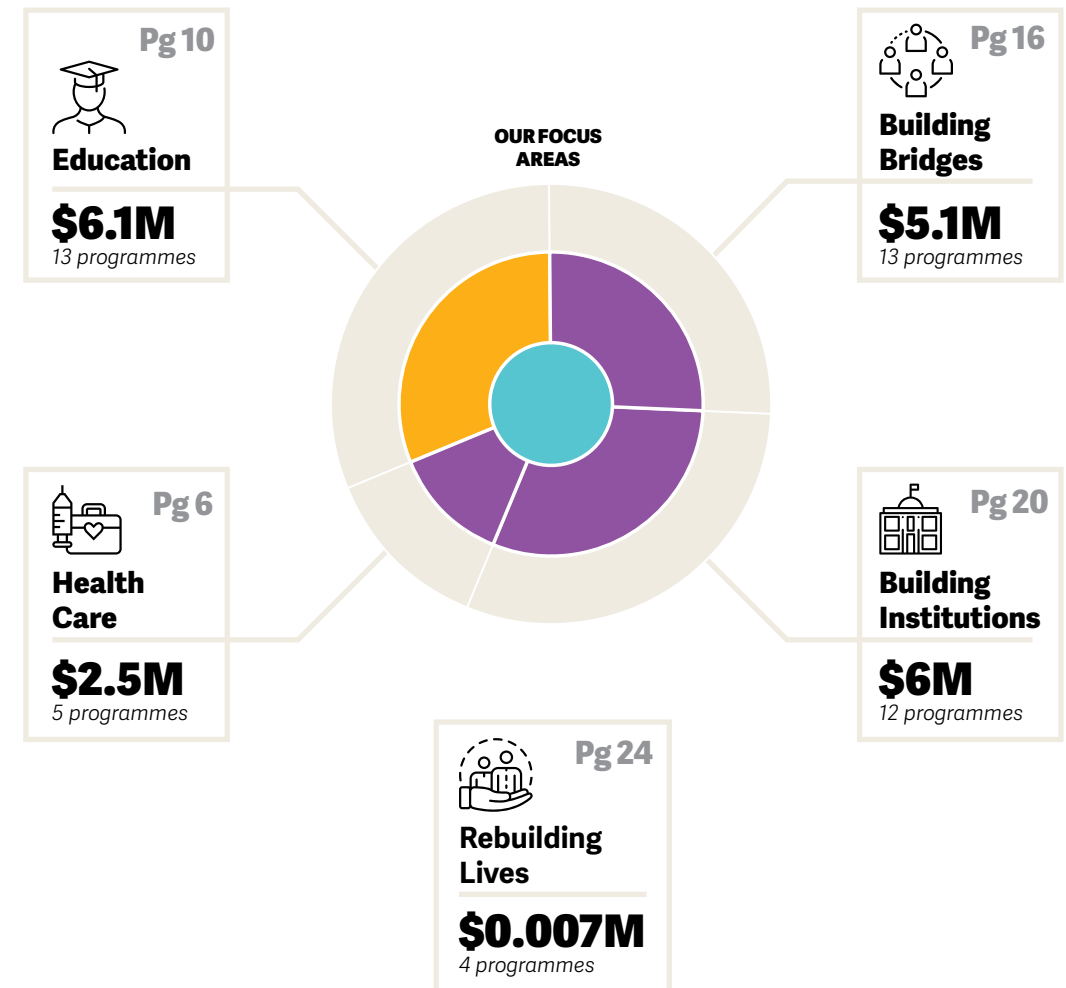

Our grant-making is grounded in three core principles. Each year, as we decide on the programmes to support, we translate these principles into action.



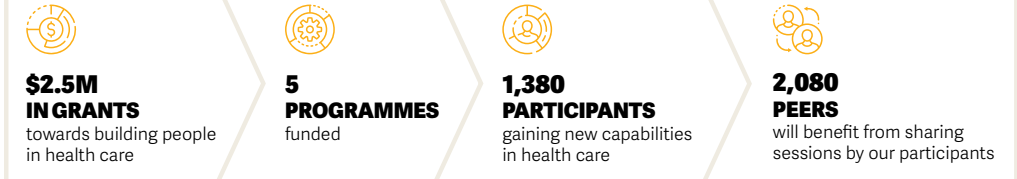

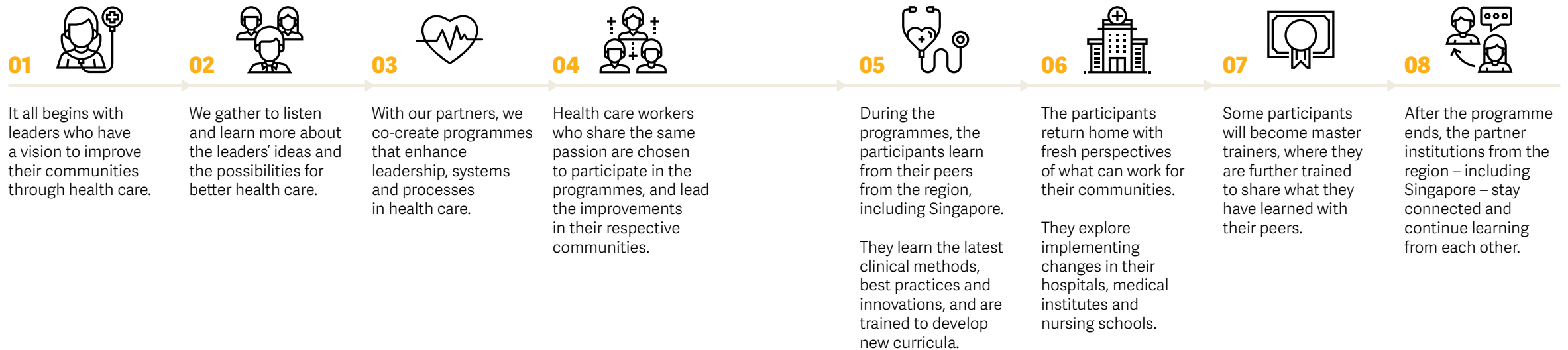


Health Care

2017/2018 Programme Highlights

Nursing Management

Nurses are at the forefront of patient care. Our programmes develop their managerial, pedagogical and clinical skills to keep pace with this ever-evolving industry.

CHINA

- **630** health care workers are being equipped with enhanced nursing management capabilities
- **800** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

PHILIPPINES

- **100** health care workers are being equipped with managerial, pedagogical and clinical skills

Health Care Management

Good leadership drives quality patient care. We support programmes to empower people to lead hospitals and public health care systems effectively.

Public Health Care

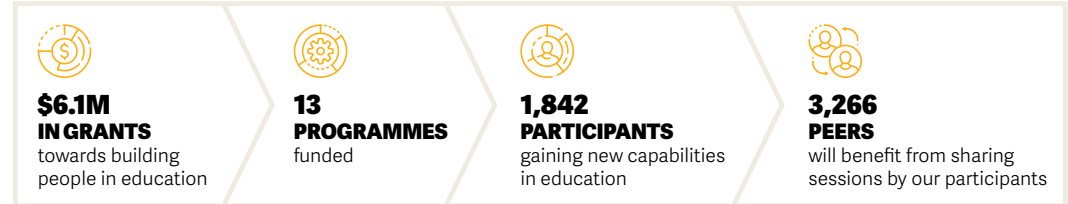
Public health programmes promote healthy communities in two ways: by raising awareness of good practices and enhancing public health management.

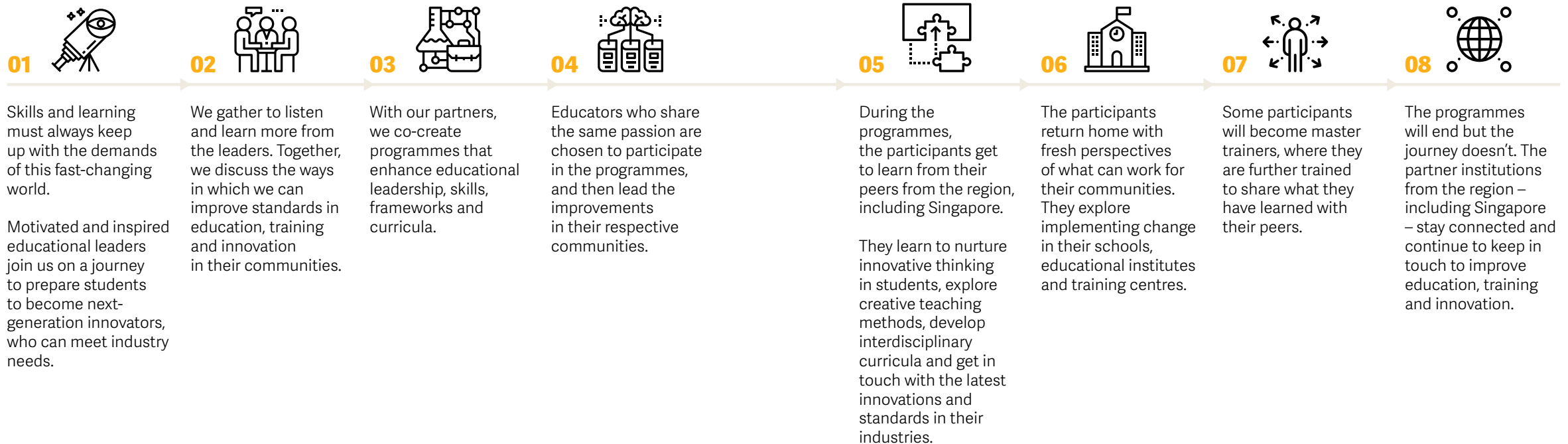

Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET)

TVET builds a dynamic workforce that meets industry needs and contributes to economic growth. TVET programmes come in various forms, but all of them enhance pedagogy, curriculum, knowledge and skills towards innovation.

Conceive-Design-Implement-Operate (CDIO)

The CDIO initiative is an international educational framework that nurtures next-generation engineers by immersing them in real-world environments. Our participants are trained to tap CDIO to raise the standards of engineering education.

CHINA

MONGOLIA

- **185** educators from 6 universities
- **100** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

PHILIPPINES

Entrepreneurship with Design Thinking

Design Thinking dissects entrepreneurship into actionable steps that people can adopt and use in their innovation processes. Our participants are educators, trainers and officials, who tap Design Thinking to raise TVET standards in vocational institutions.

THAILAND

- **80** leaders and specialists
- **240** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

TVET

We support various TVET programmes, which are a critical component of a country's education system.

INDIA

- **100** leaders will raise standards of TVET in Odisha to empower youths with better skills
- **300** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

INDONESIA

- **100** leaders will enhance TVET to prepare students for a knowledge-based economy
- **300** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

MYANMAR

- **100** officials aim to develop a national TVET Quality Assurance Framework

Digital Economy Skills

As the global digital economy becomes more important than ever, the need to constantly keep up with trends and technologies and stay relevant is critical. This series of programmes for educators and officials in Indonesia will strengthen the country's digital ecosystem in two key areas.

INDONESIA

- The Digital Economy Skills programme equips educators with capabilities to enhance their IT curricula
- **65** educators from various polytechnics and universities
- **90** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants
- The E-Commerce Logistics Skills programme equips educators with capabilities to prepare students for the fast-changing e-commerce logistics industry
- **120** specialists from 5 polytechnics and **100** officials
- **150** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM)

STEM education trains students to solve real-life issues with an inter-disciplinary and applied approach.



PHILIPPINES

- **142** specialists are being equipped with STEM education capabilities
- **426** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

University Leadership

Through the Programme for Leaders in University Management (PLUM), university leaders from Southeast Asia sharpen their leadership skills and strengthen their networks to enhance higher education in the region.

SOUTHEAST ASIA

- **60** leaders from 10 universities in the region discussed leadership, governance and growing universities through digitally-enhanced education, internationalisation and entrepreneurship
- **300** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

Educational Leadership

We support networks of schools in enhancing their educators' skills and the quality of education.

INDONESIA

- **410** educators from the Muhammadiyah network of schools are being trained in leadership, English language proficiency, instructional mastery and information technology
- **820** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

With an aim to promote mutual understanding and build bridges among peoples, Temasek Foundation International supports networking platforms for students, leaders and opinion shapers from different communities to come together.

Each platform is developed with leaders and partners, who have the like-minded mission to strengthen communities.

Each platform is a collaborative space. Participants from different backgrounds gather to bond over shared interests, learn together, exchange experiences and discuss current challenges collectively.

Just as important, the platform fosters mutual understanding by allowing participants to appreciate different cultures, languages and perspectives.

The participants return to their home countries not only with fresh ideas, perspectives and understanding, but also with new friends from across borders and expanded networks.

We encourage the friendships and networks to develop further by sustaining the platforms, hosting subsequent gatherings and connecting the participants through social media.

Student Leaders Exchange

Young leaders from polytechnics, technical institutes and universities in Asia get to develop connections and participate in cross-border community projects.

Leadership Enrichment and Regional Network (LEARN)

We partner with four universities in Singapore to equip undergraduates from the region for the future.

- The 2018 edition commemorated Singapore's ASEAN chairmanship and focused on connecting young Asian leaders

STEP Aviation Forum 2018

This forum engaged undergraduates from across the region in the landscape, developments and challenges in the aviation industry.

We partner with five polytechnics in Singapore to empower student leaders from the region to apply their skills in community service projects.

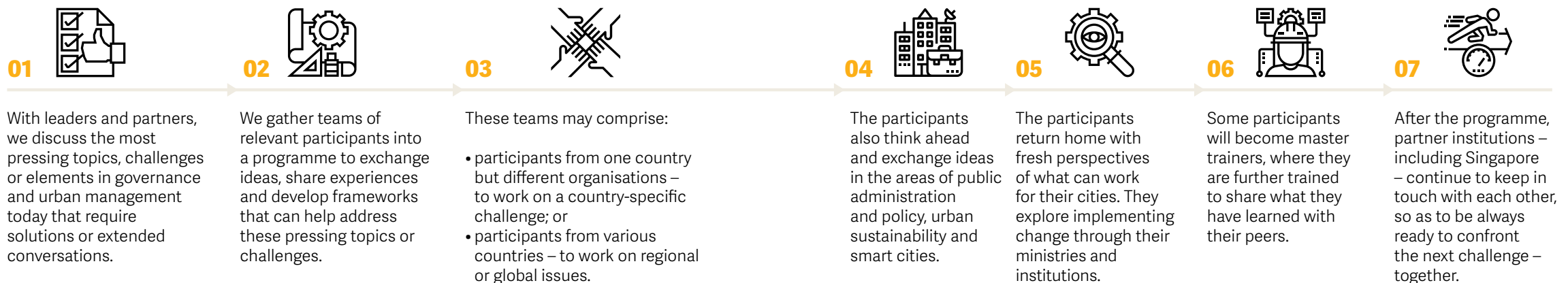

Urban Management

Cities are hubs of economic and social development. We support programmes that promote learning and understanding among policy-makers and city-planners on sustainable and liveable cities.

INDIA

- **100** officials are being equipped to develop an integrated, multimodal public transport system roadmap for Pune
- **50** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

LAO PDR

- **60** hospitality specialists are being equipped in housekeeping, front office and restaurant operations
- **180** people will benefit from sharing sessions by our participants

Rebuilding Lives

We are committed to supporting communities affected by natural disasters through disaster preparedness programmes and post-disaster efforts in rebuilding lives and livelihoods.

01



Our focus is on longer-term assistance for communities prone to natural disasters.

02



The first type of longer-term assistance is disaster preparedness. This means preparing communities to better cope in the face of a natural disaster.

In this area, we support programmes that:

- facilitate good construction practices and strengthen buildings;
- enhance the capabilities of emergency care departments; and
- equip health care workers, hospitals and systems with best practices.

03



The second type of longer-term assistance is post-disaster recovery. This means providing support to communities that help them rebuild their lives and livelihoods in a sustainable manner.

In this area, we support programmes that improve the mental well-being of those affected by disasters.

2017/2018 Highlights

Post-Disaster Recovery

We provide resources to communities that have been affected by natural disasters.

INDONESIA

- We delivered face masks and ventilators to rescue and aid workers involved in relief aid in communities affected by the Mount Agung and Mount Sinabung eruptions in February 2018
- **16,301** face masks
- **688** ventilators
